## CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- Open to all wanting to participate. Only financial members of clubs affiliated with GolfWA with valid GA handicaps can win daily or perpetual prizes. Players without a valid GA handicap will be allocated the following handicaps – Men GA 18.0 & Women GA 27.0. All players can win novelty prizes.
- 2. Players will retain the same GA handicap for the 54 holes.
- 3. No player may win more than one trophy in each competition (excluding perpetuals and Nearest the Pins).
- 4. Entry fees must accompany the entry form. All withdrawals must be sent in writing to GolfWA.
- 5. Entries places are limited to 70 people, once this allocation is met interested parties will be placed on waitlist.
- 6. The Rules of Golf as adopted by the Royal and Ancient Golf Club of St Andrews shall apply together with the Local Rules as drawn up by GolfWA in conjunction with the local club.
- 7. GolfWA reserves the right to vary any of the conditions at any time.
- Motorised Golf Carts are permitted to be used by any player providing they are available. <u>Cart availability is</u> <u>limited</u>. Carts will be distributed to players in the order in which completed entries requesting carts are received.
- 9. All courses and club houses are SMOKE FREE. This includes cigars, e-cigarettes and vaping.
- 10. Drug Testing: All competitors are subject to drug testing by the Australian Sports Drug Agency for banned substances as laid down in the Golf Australia Doping Policy. Any competitor infringing this policy or refusing to take a test may be disqualified. A copy of the policy is available at <u>www.golfaustralia.org.au</u>
- 11. Player Code of Conduct: All entrants assent to be bound by the GolfWA Code of Conduct. A copy of the Code is available on the GolfWA website <a href="http://www.golfwa.org.au">www.golfwa.org.au</a>
- 12. All ties will be decided by the Australian Countback Method.
- 13. Entries close Thursday 14<sup>th</sup> August 2025 at 4pm.
- 14. Players must comply with advice from the Australian Government's Department of Health, the State Government's Department of Health, Golf Australia (GA) and GolfWA regarding the COVID-19 virus and all requirements of the host clubs.
